

**INVITATION TO BID  
NELIGH-OAKDALE PUBLIC SCHOOLS  
RUNNING TRACK CONSTRUCTION**

- 1. PROJECT INFORMATION.** Antelope County School District 02-0009, commonly known as Neligh-Oakdale Public Schools (School District), is requesting proposals from qualified individuals or entities for the installation and construction of a running track. Project details are as follows:

**A. Scope and Nature.** The project will include a 6 Lane running track (with 2 cement chutes.) The running track will have a minimum of 4" post tension concrete paving, or an asphalt base paving as an alternate may be considered. The track surface shall have 1/2" polyurethane base mat with track event/lane lines marking and painting, The 40' x 60' high jump area will have a minimum of 4" concrete base paving, or an asphalt base as an alternate, with 1/2" polyurethane base mat, the 115' long pole vault runway with 1/2" polyurethane surfacing placed on the present cement base and two 150' long concrete long jump and triple jump runways with 1/2" polyurethane surfacing placed on the present cement base. See paragraph 5 below to obtain more specific bid specifications.

**B. Site.** Neligh-Oakdale Public Schools, 600 J Street, Neligh, NE.

**C. Schedule.** Installation shall begin on or about April 1, 2016. The project shall be completed no later than August 1, 2016.

**2. BID SUBMISSION.** 2 copies of the bids shall be addressed and delivered in a sealed envelope to Neligh-Oakdale Public Schools, Board of Education, Attn: Superintendent, 600 J Street, Neligh, NE 68756-0149. Bids shall be plainly marked with the name of the bid and the time of the bid opening. Bids will be received until 4:00p.m. (Central Time) on December 1, 2015. Any bid received after that time and date will not be opened or considered, and will be returned to the bidder.

**3. OPENING OF BIDS.** Bids will be opened publicly and simultaneously in the presence of bidders and/or their representatives beginning at 4:00p.m. on December 7, 2015, or as soon as possible thereafter, in the Office of the Superintendent of Schools.

**4. AWARDING OF BID.** The bid will be awarded to the lowest responsible, responsive bidder. The winning bid shall be announced by the Board of Education at its meeting to be held on December 14, 2015, or at such other meeting determined by the Board.

**5.
